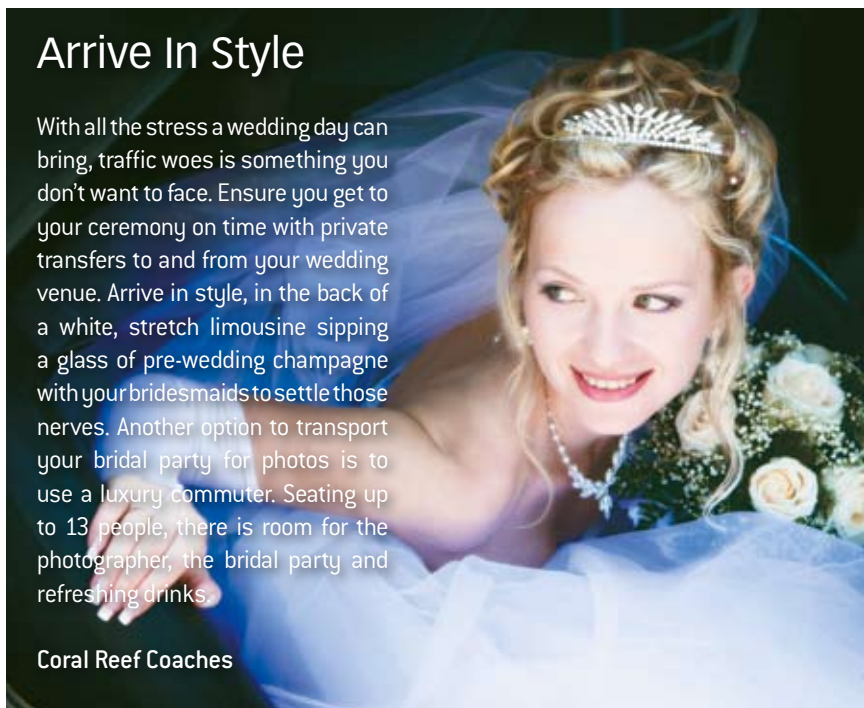

Arrive In Style

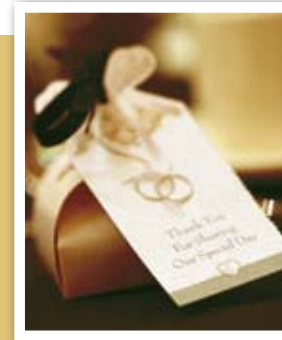

Wedding Favours

- Use silver photo frames to display place cards on your reception tables. When you send out thank you cards, attach a suitably sized wedding photo guests can display in their frame if they choose.

- If you are on a tight budget, make your own favours using simple, practical items and cute slogans.
- Buy small jars, a few kilos of coffee beans (ground or unground) and design custom labels with your wedding date, names and 'Perfect Blend' across the top.
- Take small packets of seeds for the flowers you used at your wedding, or a plant of your choice, and attach a tag with your info and 'Love Grows.'
